A) Introduction

Our culture is separating generations more than ever before. *Yet, there's never been a time that women need each other more.* Mentoring bridges the gap between generations. Women of different ages, cultures, races, backgrounds are called to grasp each other's hands across generations and pull each other up.

The word of God states that women are to be "reverent in their behavior, not malicious gossips, nor addicted to much wine, teaching what is right and good, so that they may encourage the young women to tenderly love their husbands and their children, to be sensible, pure, makers of a home [where God is honored], good-natured, being subject to their own husbands, so that the word of God will not be dishonored." Titus 2: 3-5 AMP

Mentoring is an intentional relationship between an older person and a younger person. It is walking through life together for a season, sharing wisdom, life experiences and growing in a relationship with Christ.

- B) There are four critical steps to implementing a mentoring program:
 Embrace Becoming familiar with mentoring processes
 Engage Getting leaders and mentors on board
 Equip Recruiting, preparing and training mentors
 Connect Recruiting mentees, matching mentors and mentees and meet-ups
 - 1 Embrace

Spiritual mentoring is a triadic relationship between mentor, mentee and the Holy Spirit; where the mentee can discover ultimate identity as a child of God and a unique voice for Kingdom responsibility. (Anderson, Randy, Reese-Spiritual Mentoring)

- Jesus and His disciples- New Testament

Our family unity has disintegrated. Fast pace of society keeps women from developing real relationships (Social Media – Facebook, Snapchat, Instagram, Texting, FOMO). God has issued a clear call to older women to take what we have learned over the years to encourage women.

2 <u>– Engage</u>

Gain support from Church leaders by sharing your vision, your passion and your willingness to lead. Your level of preparedness will impact how your request is received. Be bold, be confident.

3 **– <u>Equip</u>**

Preparing Mentors to mentor; set standards for success, develop a covenant document. Spend time in Bible study and prayer; develop confidence; emphasize importance of trust in the relationship.

4 <u>– Connect</u>

Recruiting mentees, make announcements to all groups. Matching mentors with mentees. Give consideration to individuals' needs, geographical location. Kick off celebration to launch program.

Establish meeting times for support, accountability, and feedback.
