



#### **RE: SONRISE RETREAT CENTRE 2016 END OF YEAR UPDATE**

#### **Beloved Brethren in Christ :**

Loving greetings in Jesus' precious name as we come to the threshold of another new year. Since our last update on the construction works to you, we pleased to advise that we have just about completed the preparation of the ground floor for casting of the floor slab. The above photos show that the basic electrical conduits and the water and sewer pipes have been installed.

Accordingly, at the earliest opportunity in the new year (DV), we are looking forward to completing the required similar installations on the first floor and proceeding to casting both floor slabs. In order to achieve this we will need to fund the cost of 240 yards of concrete plus plumbing and electrical material and labour estimated at \$260,000.00 (TT). We are trusting the Lord to provide as He has graciously done in the past and look forward to the continued prayerful, practical and financial support of Saints.

Attached is a copy of the project's most recent financial statement (in TT\$) for your consideration.

We propose to do another site cleanup on Saturday 21<sup>st</sup>. January, 2017, and look forward to your usual cooperation.

We would appreciate if persons who make donations via direct deposit to the project account, (Republic Bank account #200010638501 in the name of Carnbee Gospel Hall) would kindly advise us in order that we can provide the appropriate receipt/acknowledgement.

#### January 5, 2017

Dear Brothers and Sisters in the Lord,

My wife, Fidele, and I are pleased to report that the Lord has been wonderful in His works in 2016. He has brought us through tests including illnesses and has landed us safely on New Year's shore.

We thank Him for those of you who have supported us through prayers and even in practical ways. But we must confess that we have seen Him work miracles in some cases to meet needs.

While invitations to preach among our assemblies have all but dried up, Nestor feels that this is part of God's plan as he continues to sense the urge to focus on the southern wing of Antigua.

One young man to whom Nestor witnessed and for whom we have prayed much was shot in his home on Christmas day and died two days ago. His mother who did respond to our preaching had died at the break of the New Year in 2015. His brother had died through misadventure earlier in 2014.

The Love and Service Broadcast heard on The Caribbean Radio Lighthouse in the Leeward Islands and on Harbour Light on the Windward Islands continues to draw responses from appreciative listeners.

During 2016, Nestor had the privilege of ministering in a

week of meetings at Shiloh Gospel Hall here in Antigua and in August he presented the Gospel in a week of meetings in Golden Grove.

In September, the main Independent Baptist church invited him to speak at their Sunday Service . Another invited him to address a Sunday afternoon event in October and then in November, he was invited to be the speaker at their United Service at a cultural centre where 13 Baptist churches assembled with hundreds in the congregation. The officiating pastor commented that the nearly one hour long message looked like only fifteen minutes. There were ripples of applause during the message and prolonged applause at the end. The Spirit of God gave great freedom. To God be the Glory.

In our assembly, God met our need for a projector, a printer and related items by allowing us to get all for what was virtually the price of one. He then provided the church a bus through the kindness of a brother and his wife. He also solved the transportation woes of the 'Campbells'. Praise be to His Name.

In August the 'Campbells' rejoiced as their daughter, Adele, was married to Kedane Gamble of Barbados. Kedane became both a husband to Adele and a ministering addition to our church. God be praised.

We have again restarted our Youth Ministry and will replace our Sunday morning Children's Programme with a full fledged Sunday School. Our focus for 2017 is Winning the Young for Christ

May the Lord bless you all and your family members in your various services and ministries for our Lord.
